The process of applying for accreditation and undergoing an intense review of all divisions of the Sheriff's Office has taken many months. An accreditation team spent three days in November interviewing deputies and civilian staff, quizzing them on agency policies and procedures.

All members of the Flagler County Sheriff's Office were proud when the Sheriff announced that the county's largest law enforcement agency was being recommended for accreditation.

Although every employee of the Sheriff's Office had a role in the accreditation process, Deputy First Class John Gaspar led the team that coordinated the months of preparation.

In recognition of his work, DFC Gaspar was named "Employee of the Quarter" for the fourth quarter of 2004 during ceremonies this week at the Flagler County Sheriff's Office in Bunnell.

"This recommendation for accreditation is the high-water mark for this agency and my administration," said Sheriff Jim Manfre, as he presented Gaspar the award. "We are one of only four agencies to be recommended for accreditation by the Commission in February and we are the last in Northeast Florida to become accredited."

Sheriff Manfre also thanked Accreditation Assistant Wendy Bentzley, DFC Mike Fink, Corporal Greg Weston and Shannon Sandberg for their efforts in coordinating the various divisions as the agency moved to meet the goals and objectives of the accreditation commission.

"I am very proud of the work everyone here has done and I thank John for stepping forward to lead this effort," the Sheriff said.
